Musician, Producer and Founder of the Gandhi Tour and Music 4 Peace

Since 2000 were Tobias Huber, Founder of Music 4 Peace had started this cultural peace foundation; Music 4 Peace had supported international cultural peace projects in alliance with organizations as M. K. Gandhi Institute, Culture of Peace Initiative, SUISA Foundation, Pathways to Peace, Earthdance, 30 Days of Peace, UN Millennium Development Goals, White Band Org, We the World and many others. Music 4 Peace had supported events as the United Nation's "No Excuse Concert" in New York in 2004, relating to the Millennium Development Goals, supported the world-fusion Group 1001 Ways attending on of Asia's largest Festivals, the "World Performing Arts Festival" 2003 and 2004. Tobias presented The Gandhi Tour, at the Int. Earthdance peace festival in California 2006, celebrating Gandhi's "100 Years of Non-violence" with Dr. Arun Gandhi, the grandson of the late Mahatma. As well presented 30 Days of Peace and The Gandhi Tour at the world's largest music industry fair MIDEM 2007, Gandhi Tour Concerts at Donna Karan's Event location in New York and the historical Kingsley Hall in London 2008. Concerts at Int. Day of Peace at UN in New York, Gandhi Tour TV broadcast celebrating Gandhi's 140th birthday by supporting the "World March for Peace and Non-violence". Lunch of the Music 4 Peace Tour with a Press Conference feat. Def Jam Founder Russell Simmons at Sundance Film Festival in 2010.

Tobias is as well a Producer as a Musician of the World Fusion Project 1001Ways, who performed at International Festivals around the globe. Born in a prestigious Swiss Musician Family (son of Klaus Huber, avant-garde composer) his Grandmother comes from the Django Reinhardt Family, his teachers were Volker Biesenbender (Master-student of Sir Yehudi Menuhin), Mustapha Tettey Addy, Ali Akbar Khan, Zakir Hussein, the Bauls of Bengal and many others. Tobias Huber achieved several International Awards: Int. Music Festival Sanden Netherlands 1990, Int. Music Festival in Vevey Switzerland 1995, Indie-Tunes Song Contest Finalist 2006, top 40 US / Peace Song-writing Award 2006. Since his early years Tobias was inspired of Gandhi's Non-violence actions and worked with cultural peace projects since the 80's. "now it is more important then ever to unite for Peace!"




An innovative mixture of World Music and new Sounds

1001 Ways World Fusion Project (works together with various international guest musicians) is founded and lead by violinist Tobias Huber, who hails from a musical family (His Grandmother comes from the Django Reinhardt family). Tobias is based in Switzerland and is truly about global music. Hi have recorded the CD "Gandhi". It is based on musical and spiritual traditions that are thousands of years old as well as blending modern pop sounds and chill-out elements. The truly exciting aspect of the CD is the combination of there extraordinary music with the rare recording of Mahatma Gandhi's voice (It comes with the blessing of Dr. Arun Gandhi, Mahatma Gandhi's grandson). This CD did break borders in all senses. 1001 Ways had performed at International Festivals around the world and are touring now with there energetic multimedia live performance, including original Film footage's of Mahatma Gandhi. (1001 Ways had international media coverage on BBC, London to Night, Forbes TV, Asian Voice, India Digest, Culture Times, Pakistan TV, Sirus Radio...). 1001 Ways had worked together with international artists like:

Farafina (Real World), Fathy Salama (producer of "Egypt" for Youssou N'Dour), Omega III (producer of Madonna...), Gypsy Kings, Tony Scott, Boddy Miles and Calvin Owens.







- 1001 Ways has had the honour to perform for the celebration of 100 Years of Non-violence, featuring Dr. Arun Gandhi (Mahatma Gandhi's grandson), at the launch of the Gandhi Tour at the Earthdance peace festival California in 2006. In 2007 the band performed at the Gandhi Tour Benefit Event at Donna Karan's Steven Weiss Studio in New York, concluding "30 Day of Pace" supported by the United Nations. In the same year they performed at the Medallion Entertainment Gala in Hollywood with Wayne Warwick (DjunDjetti) Master Didgeridoo player from Australia (1001 Ways on stage with Gypsy Kings, Buddy Miles, The Gap Band, Calvin Owens...), the Gandhi Tour Concert at the historical Kingsley Hall in London and at the Music 4 Peace / Gibson Guitar lounge / Sundance Film Festival 2010, jamming with Elan (The Wailers) and John Forte (Fugees).
- The latest historical CD release "Gandhi", featuring the original voice of Mahatma Gandhi (spiritual message 1931) breaks borders in all senses. With deep lyrics and a large multicultural background, 1001 Ways transports a musical vision of peace and tolerance to the world.
- Years ago the band was performing and travelling with some of the legends of the Bauls of Bengal and other folk musicians throughout India and Pakistan. 1001 Ways have also performed at cultural venues and at International Festivals around the world.
- In its "Small Peace World Tour 2004" (New York Switzerland Lahore/Pakistan), 1001 Ways played at the UN "No Excuse Concert" in New York, signifying their support of the Millennium Development Goals fighting hunger and poverty as well as at the World Performing Arts Festival 2003 / 2004 (One of the largest Int. Performing Arts Festival in Asia).
- The group had always remained attracted to a cultural dialogue and is strongly inspired by Gandhi's life of non-violence and multicultural understanding. "One Love 1001 Ways"

"He had four sons. My father is his second son. I grew up in South Africa, where we were treated badly and suffered those filled with anger, seeking revenge. My father died in prison fighting apartheid. I was taken to

India where, between the ages of 12 and 14, I lived with Grandfather for 18 months. In his
